SCAP is a powerful computer program designed to run on the very popular System-80 computer. It has been written in Australia, specifically to meet the needs of small to medium Australian business firms. Here are some of the many outstanding features which it can offer YOU, to help you run your business more efficiently, more confidently and more profitably:

- Control and management of up to 1200 stock lines.
- Simple "menu-driven" operation, whereby the program itself asks you what you want to do, then guides you by telling you how to do it.
- The ability to get up-to-date information for any stock item in seconds, on the video screen.
- The use of an exclusive machine-language sorting routine, which allows SCAP to add new items to your system in the correct order three times faster than with similar existing systems. Maximum sorting time is around 7 minutes, instead of 20 minutes.
- The ability to get an up-to-date summary of your overall stock position at any time, again in seconds. Concise information on the number of lines out of stock, below minimum stock level, on order, etc., monthto-date and year-to-date sales figures, plus the amounts of money you have tied up in stock-on-hand and committed to stock on order.

- The ability to produce up-to-date (and dated) printed price lists and stock status listings whenever you need them. All of these printed listings may be of either all items in the system, or for selected subgroups: item categories selected by number prefix, by supplier, or by status (out of stock, below minimum stock level, on order etc.). In order to run SCAP on your System-80 computer and get the full benefit of its features, you will need at least the following hardware items:

1 x System-80 computer, video monitor and expansion unit, with total of 32K of RAM memory.

2 x 40-track floppy disk drives with daisy-chain cable and power supply.

1 x 132-column printer with cable.

Easy Expansion

SCAP has been designed specifically to make it easy for either you, or the software programmer of your choice to extend its capabilities, if you wish, as your business grows.

The SCAP program is written in easilyunderstood BASIC language, and a full listing is supplied to you when you buy it. This makes modification and expansion quite straightforward.

And the biggest feature of all is that you get all of these powerful features for a tiny fraction of the price you'd have to pay for such a system before SCAP came along!
